The Netball Scholarship offered at Wath Academy Sixth Form is a specialist 16-18 netball programme that ensures all students access a first-class netball experience in addition to their post-16 education. All players on the scholarship programme undertake A Levels or vocational subjects during the course with further possibilities to acquire work-based qualifications such as England Netball Level 1 course. Scholars access a high-quality netball provision working with Netball England-qualified coaches. The programme involves training on a daily basis with the scholarship coaching team this provides players with a fantastic opportunity to further develop their netball education and knowledge of the game.
