Over the last few weeks, we have asked for feedback from all stakeholders on our current uniform to help us refine our uniform policy for September 2022. We have listened to this feedback, and our uniform expectations will remain unchanged. However, Academy approved skirts will now come in an extended range of sizes to allow students to wear the skirt to the knee. These can be purchased directly from our two uniform suppliers:
