Principal's Update

Dear Students / Parents / Carers,

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As we approach the half term break it gives us another opportunity to reflect on some of the highlights of the past few weeks:

B11 Education

As part of our drive for continuous improvement we engaged in an external audit by B11 Education. Three trained OFSTED inspectors arrived and performed a number of Subject Deep Dives as well as a meeting with leaders and teachers across a range of areas including, behaviour, attendance, personal development and safeguarding.

The feedback we received was very positive. Subjects such as Science, Maths and History coming out with significant strengths and English also being seen as rapidly improving. Behaviour and Safeguarding at the academy was also highlighted as a strength. Particularly pleasing was the feedback regarding our Personal Development programme. The visitors highlighted the Character Education, Votes for Schools, Life Skills and Enrichment programmes as being real strengths of the academy.

As always, we reflect on the areas for development and have already started implementing feedback on how we can develop student voice and even further improve the Personal Development curriculum.

Ministerial Visit

This half term we had a visit from the Minister of State for School Standards, Robin Walker. He visited the area to look at the Attendance Matters pathway RMBC have implemented in conjunction with local schools. The local authority selected us as the school they'd like to show the Minister around.

It was great to welcome the Minister and tour him around the academy, he was very impressed with the curriculum offer across all key stages in particular the broad range of subjects in the sixth form. He was particularly pleased with the standards of behaviour and commented positively on the progress the academy is making.



To be selected by the local authority and to then impress the Minister of State for School Standards on a tour around the academy is a fantastic achievement and something staff and students should be very proud of. This is another indicator that the academy is making significant improvements.



Music Mark

It is an exciting time in the Music department with the installation of the new IT workstations and other new music equipment such as guitars, drum kits and keyboards. We are aiming to provide students with industry standard equipment on which to work.

In addition, the Music department are delighted to have been nominated by Rotherham Music to become a Music Mark school in recognition of their commitment to music education. Music Mark is the UK Association for Music Education, championing and supporting access to music for all young people and it is an honour to have been chosen.
