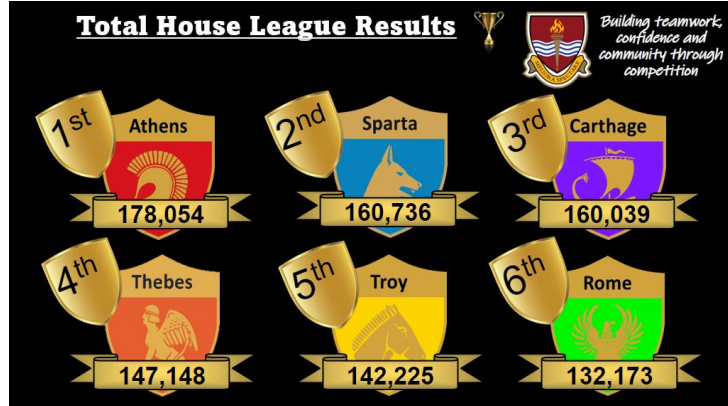

The day was hosted by Hepp and the ambassadors did a fantastic job sharing their experiences and showing the students around the campus.

Engineering Development Trust (EDT)

Some students from Y9 and Y10 are taking part in the EDT project, working with GFG Liberty Steels on a number of tasks such as looking at old buildings and suggesting proposed changes to make them more environmentally friendly. All year groups have been involved in an exciting STEM based house challenge, where they had to use their scientific skills to purify the most salt in order to win. We still have lots of exciting events to come, for example, our Y7 students are looking forward to a visit to the Yorkshire Wildlife Park and STEM competitions against the other secondary schools within the trust.
