Dyslexia top tips for teachers

Get child's attention before speaking

Break down instructions into small chunks

Print out worksheets

Avoid white backgrounds on power points

Don't overload with information

Use Arial or Comic Sans font

Give extra time to process information

Use visual cues

Emphasise key words- provide subject specific key words

Take advantage of assistive technology, Reading pens, Dragon Speek.

Encourage to use a laptop to record work

Use repetition, visualisation.

Only ask to read out loud if you know they want to

Pre-teach key vocabulary

Allow additional reading time

Give brain breaks (where possible)

Provide sentence starters, writing frames and mind maps.

Scaffold work

Check understanding before moving on
